PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project foresees setting up scouting summer camps mainly during the summer period (June-August). Camping periods might initially last from 5 to 10 days and take place in areas such as the Lake or Dajti and Kashar Parks where youth can participate in outdoor activities. One of the main purposes is to combine entertaining activities with individual training, crucial to the psychology, emotional and social development of the respective age groups.

Summer camps provide a pleasant environment for children and youth to learn new experiences and connect socially and emotionally. They also create a collaborative environment by building mutual trust.

OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Incite young people physical, mental and spiritual development, through outdoors activities and enhancement of their survival skills.

PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION MODALITY

Develop a program of informal education with an emphasis on practical outdoor activities, including camping, woodcraft, aquatics, hiking, backpacking, and sports

Design and apply awareness campaigns on personal security, possible threats and risks and the importance to help each - other.

Engage actively children and youth in the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation processes during the summer camp.
