PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Tirana Lake Grand Park has many green spaces, but there is an absence of flower gardens. This project will be able to respond to these needs in terms of growing decorative trees. The project will ensure the creation of spaces for the plantation of Japanese cherry trees along the streets and alleys of the park.

The decorative cherry trees grow up to 5 - 10 meters both in height as well as width. The trees bloom in mid-spring offering a stunning view. Japanese cherry blossoms are white and /or pinkish. They can be planted along the parks' roads creating flowery tunnels. In many cherry blossoms parks around the world, festivals are in early spring, celebrating the start of the season. This can turn into a tradition for Tirana and the Grand Lake Park.

OVERALL OBJECTIVE

The project aims to create spaces with planted decorative cherry blossom trees lacoated within the Tirana Lake Grand Park. By doing so, the Municipality intends to create a pleasant and relaxing environment for all ages in this area.

PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION MODALITY

The palnting process stretches over a period of 3-6 months, starting from December. The project implementation includes the identetification of planting territory, detailed planning and landscape architecture of the planned plantation. Training of local staff to grow and maintain the decorative cherry blossom trees.

PRELIMINARY IMPACTS

Creating recreational and attractive areas for visitors/frequenters of the park. Improving the floral silhuette of the capital and enhance the diversity of decorative and colorful greenery of Tirana. Offer recreational opportunities and incentives for young people to come closer with nature. The creation of this decorative and colourful space will have a direct impact on the 5000-10000 daily park visitors.
