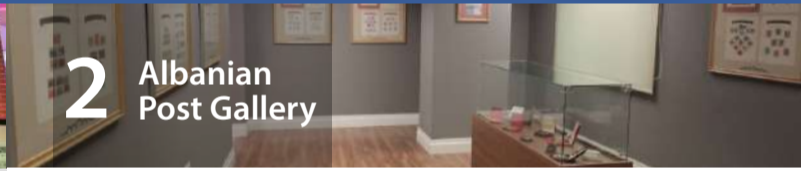
1 Tirana Art Gallery (TAG)

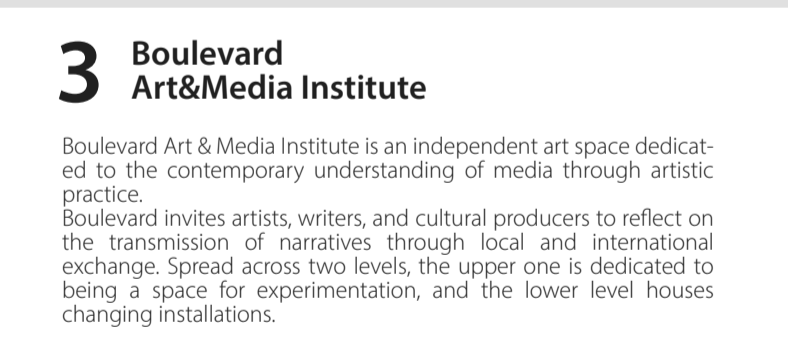
2 Albanian Post Gallery

Albanian Post Gallery reflects the history of the Albanian postage stamp since its first emission, on May 5, 1913. The gallery is divided into three periods: The first period from 1913 - 1944, the second period from 1945 - 1990, the third period from 1991 - to nowadays. The public can watch in the video room the documentary dedicated to the history of the Albanian postage stamp, which intertwines nicely with the history of the Albanian state since its independence on November 28, 1912.

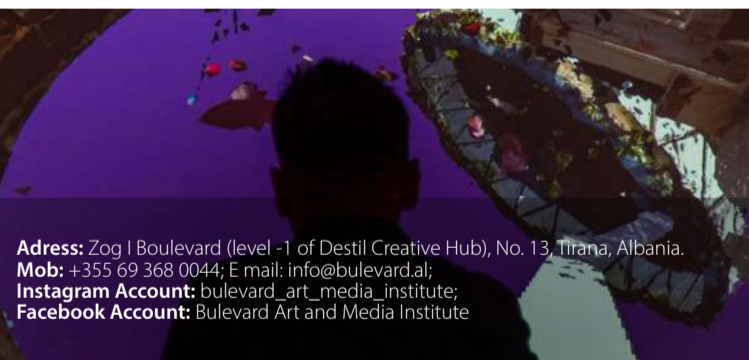

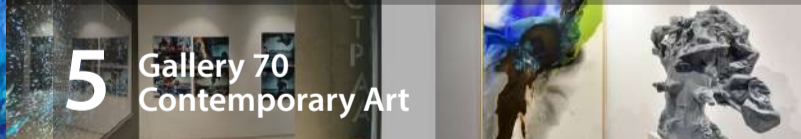
4 Tirana Ekspres (The alternative art space of Tirana)

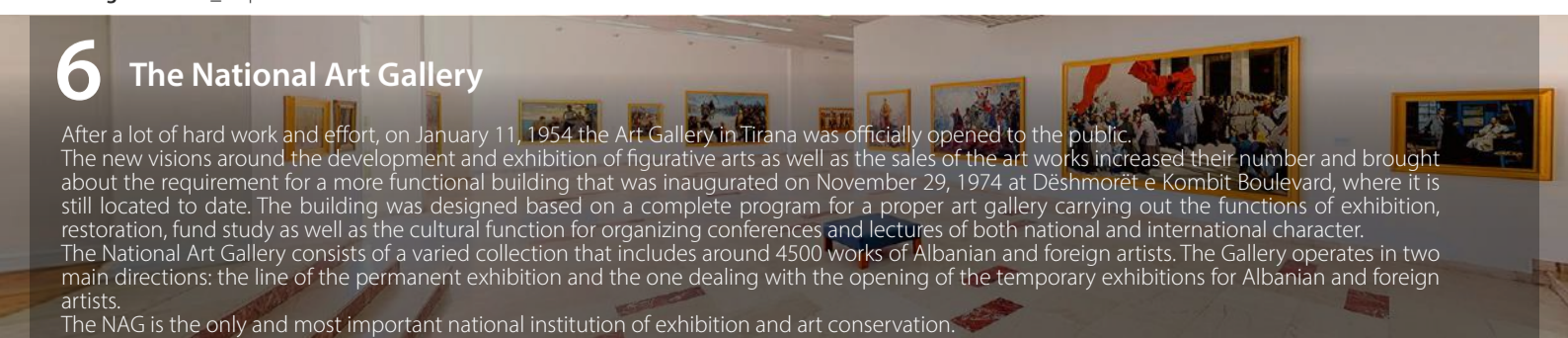
5 Gallery 70 Contemporary Art

6 The National Art Gallery



After a lot of hard work and effort, on January 11, 1954 the Art Gallery in Tirana was officially opened to the public. The new visions around the development and exhibition of figurative arts as well as the sales of the art works increased their number and brought about the requirement for a more functional building that was inaugurated on November 29, 1974 at Dëshmorët e Kombit Boulevard, where it is still located to date. The building was designed based on a complete program for a proper art gallery carrying out the functions of exhibition, restoration, fund study as well as the cultural function for organizing conferences and lectures of both national and international character. The National Art Gallery consists of a varied collection that includes around 4500 works of Albanian and foreign artists. The Gallery operates in two main directions: the line of the permanent exhibition and the one dealing with the opening of the temporary exhibitions for Albanian and foreign artists. The NAG is the only and most important national institution of exhibition and art conservation.
