10 Tirana Business Park

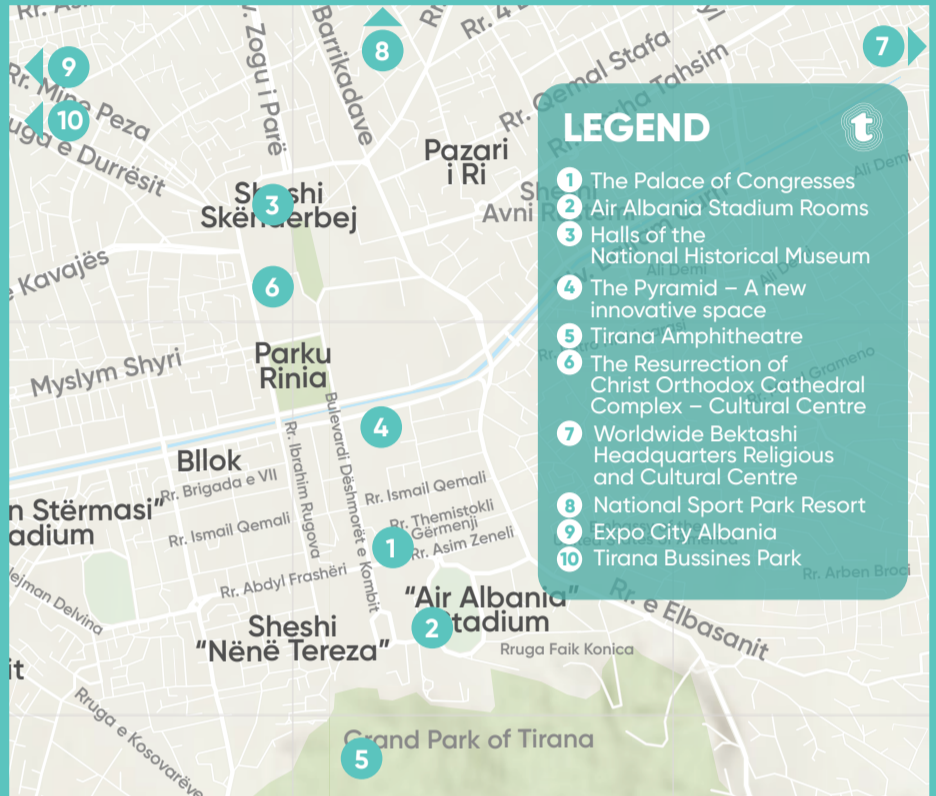

Why Tirana ?

As the capital city and as the most developed city, as the largest urban centre in Albania, the centre for the business development, the city of universities, the city of multi-coloured contrasts, Tirana is undoubtedly one of the most lively and transforming metropolis of the Western Balkans.

Tirana is located only 160 km away from Podgorica (Montenegro), 250 km away from Prishtina (Kosova), and only 4 hours away by car, or approximately 285 km away from Skopje (Northern Macedonia), as well as 725 km away from Athens (Greece). Thus, the Albanian capital city is perfectly located in the region.

Tirana is only 20 minutes away from the Mother Teresa International Airport, that represents the most important airway connection with the

world and it facilitates the fastest access to destinations, such as, London, Paris, Rome, Athens, Vienna, Frankfurt, etc. Meanwhile, charter flights to Tirana increased by 10% during 2019 compared to 2018. For more information, please visit the following link: <https://www.tirana-airport.com>

Accommodating Capacity



There are over 350 hotels, resorts, guesthouses and hostels in Tirana and its surrounding area and over 50 of these hotels and resorts provide workshop, conference and business meeting rooms that can easily compete in the international arena.

With the arrival of the internationally renowned hotel brands, such as, The Maritime Plaza (that has received many prizes for its architectonic design and is praised as one of the best congress hotels in the Balkans), The Hilton Garden Inn Tirana, The Hyatt Regency & Residences Tirana (Mak Albania), Via Hotels Group (VH Eurostar Tirana) there is an increase of the accommodating capacity for events and business tourists. Meanwhile, bearing in mind the fact that Tirana is still a capital city at the stage of transformation there are forecasts and plans for other five star hotels in the city.

The Albanian capital provides ample spaces as activity centres and regional and international ones, such as, workshops, symposiums, conferences, festivals, fairs, exhibitions, etc. With the expansion and the transformation of the New Boulevard into a recreational space that was added to the city there were also more opportunities for the increase of such spaces especially with the new buildings that will be built on both sides of the New Boulevard. With an increased accommodation capacity as well as the Palace of Congresses with a capacity of 2500 seats, Tirana now has attracted the attention of many organisers of regional and international events.

Tirana and its suburbia have also quite a considerable accommodating capacities for the organisation of different events as well as the business events. These accommodating structures with a few of them representing the renowned international brands (4-5 stars) provide more than 100 conference rooms with capacities from 20 to 2200 participants.

1 The Palace of Congresses



Is the ideal place to organise conferences, festivals, fairs and other events. It is located in the heart of Tirana near some of the largest and luxurious hotels of the city as well as near the main governmental, cultural and trade institutions, near the park and the former Block area, etc.

The Palace of Congresses was built during 1982-1986 and is managed by the Government Services Directorate.

Capacities of rooms and event facilities:

- 1- The Conference/Concert Room - capacity: 2040 seats
- 2- The Underground A Room - capacity: 200 seats
- 3- The Underground B Room - capacity: 130 seats
- 4- The Oval A Room - capacity: 27 seats around the table + 23 side seats.
- 5- The Oval B Room - capacity: 110 seats

Other available spaces:

- 6- The Underground Hall – an area of 1000 m².
- 7- The Main Hall – an area of 2380 m².
- 8- 2nd Floor Hall – an area of 1500 m².
- 9- 3rd Floor Hall – an area of 1100 m².

2 Air Albania Stadium Rooms



Air Albania Stadium is a modern sports complex that has a very interesting architecture. It remains a reference point not just for sports events, but also for cultural, artistic and entertainment events. The sports part of the stadium contains multifunctional rooms for events and other services and the rooms are equipped with contemporary technology.

Capacities of rooms for events:

- 1- VIP Room – capacity: 365 seats (2nd Floor)
- 2- Conference Room – capacity: 80 seats (1st Floor)
- 3- The Large Media Room – capacity: 90 seats (2nd Floor)
- 4- Sky Box Very Vip Room – capacity: 20 seats (2nd Floor)

3 Halls of the National Historical Museum



The Historical Museum was inaugurated on October 28, 1981 and it represents the largest museum institution in Albania. The museum building is noted for its compact volume on a quadratic plan composed in a symmetrical centre against the atrium. The building contains a few rooms that are used for conference, meetings and exhibition purposes. The rooms are managed by the National Historical Museum staff.

The capacity of rooms and business facilities for different events:

- 1- The UNESCO Room – capacity: 200 seats
- 2- Kostandin Shpataku Room – capacity: 70 seats
- 3- The Library Room – capacity: 50 seats
- 4- The Main Hall – an area of 370 m² (exhibition/reception room)
- 5- The large Exhibition Room – an area of 400 m²
- 6- The small Exhibition Room – an area of 30 m²
- 7- The former Stamps' Hall, 2nd Floor – an area of 271 m² (exhibition/reception room)
- 8- Ballkonada Room – an area of 160 m² (exhibition/conference room)
- 9- The Atrium/Internal Courtyard – an area of 800 m² (receptions/fashion shows/concerts)

4 The Pyramid – A new innovative space



The Pyramid was inaugurated on October 14, 1988 as the Museum of the dictator Enver Hoxha. After 1991 the Pyramid was transformed into Pjeter Arbërori International Cultural Centre. Many conferences, exhibitions as well as local and international fairs were carried out here.

By 2023, Tirana's Pyramid will be transformed into the largest technological centre of the region due to a revitalization and architectural transformation project creating the physiognomy of a digital epicentre in the Balkans. The Pyramid will have 18 rooms where the young people may study IT, robotics, design, and 14 classes in nature.

This creates an opportunity for the technological companies to locate here, to test their products or simply to provide capacities for internships. As such, the Pyramid may be perceived in the future as the ideal place for workshops or business events offering the most advanced digital technology in Tirana. The Pyramid is under the Tirana City Hall management.

5 Tirana Amphitheatre



Tirana Amphitheatre (rebuilt in May 2018) is the largest open space arena of the capital city with a capacity of 1334 seats. The amphitheatre equipped with the scene covered with suitable lights welcomes the public for concerts, conferences, festivals, theatres and summer cinema all year round transforming this part of Tirana into an important events point for the citizens as well as the interested businesses.

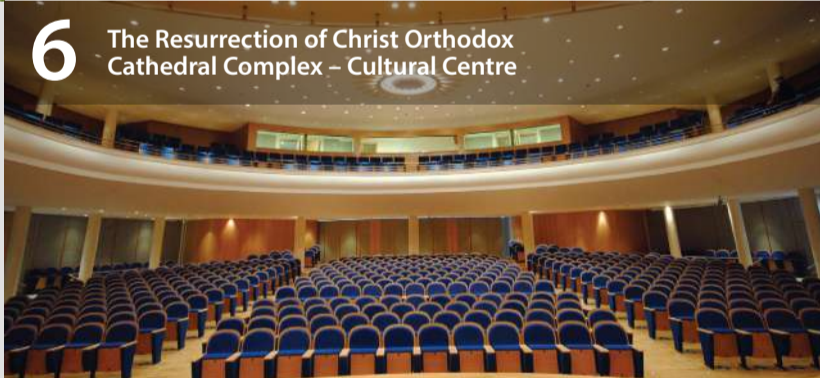

The complex is located at the Resurrection of Christ Orthodox Cathedral in the centre of Tirana and began its activities in June 2012.

The complex includes: The Amphitheatre Room – capacity: 635 seats. The room's capacity may be increased even more with the expansion of the sides up to 775 seats. This room may be used for meetings, conferences, shows and musical activities. The acoustics, technical and commodity performance of the room are very good.

6 The Resurrection of Christ Orthodox Cathedral Complex – Cultural Centre



This centre is located at the Bektashi Odeon and was inaugurated on September 7, 2015. The Odeon, a multi-functional structure has been designed and built as a unique work of its kind in the world.

The capacities of rooms and event facilities are as follows:

- 1-Conference Room - capacity: 500 seats (1st Floor) and the room is equipped with a technical back room for the simultaneous interpreting.
- The room is suitable and has natural light, contemporary equipment, AC, etc.
- 2-Meeting Room – capacity: 30 seats. This room is located at the library and is equipped with very good AC conditions as well as other suitable equipment for meetings.

The rooms are managed by Odeon's staff.

The National Sport Park Resort has a total area of around 30.000 m² with a main entrance and sufficient parking spaces (80-100 cars). It has been certified by the World Tennis Federation as the national tennis centre for our country. There is a conference room covering an effective area of 300 m² and a total area of 400 m². The rooms capacity is 200-300 seats. The room is equipped with audio, video projector and a projector screen facilities.
